Part 2: Last read WPM "Shots fired, male down," a police officer said into his radio. It was November, 2014 in a park in Cleveland, Ohio. "Black male, maybe 20... black handgun..." However, the officer was wrong. It wasn't a Black man who the White officer had just shot. It 45 was a twelve-year-old boy, Tamir Rice, who lived nearby. And it wasn't a handgun he had; it 62 was a toy gun. 66 This tragic story began with a trade. Earlier in the day, Tamir had searched through his mother's 83 drawer, looking for a plaything. He found a cellphone and brought it with him to the park. An 101 older friend offered to take the phone to a store to have the service unlocked. Tamir was 118 excited to borrow his friend's lifelike toy gun. He played around with it in the park. 134 What happened next? A series of upsetting events led to the moment when Tamir was killed. 150 The 911 caller said that the gun was "probably fake." He said the person holding it was 167 "probably a juvenile." This important information, however, wasn't communicated to the 178 192 officers. One of the officers, Timothy Loehmann, had a history of emotional instability.
