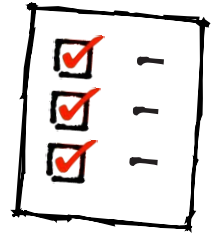

| The Ku Klux Klan grew larger during the civil rights movement. Many White people were angry. They did not want Black people to have the same rights. The KKK used beatings, bombings, and shootings to try to scare people. They wanted to stop people from voting or speaking out. Since the 1960s, the Ku Klux Klan’s numbers have gone down.
