In 1958, the Ku Klux Klan planned a rally in North Carolina. Many of the Lumbee Indian people lived in the area. There were rumors that a Lumbee woman was dating a White man. This rumor made Ku Klux Klan members angry. The Ku Klux Klan planned a rally to scare the Lumbee people. Only about 50 people actually 59 76 came. However, hundreds of Lumbee men came to break up the rally. The leader of the rally fled so fast he left his wife behind. One Lumbee leader said, "We drove the KKK out, and they 95 98 haven't came back." The Ku Klux Klan, or KKK, is an American hate group. The first KKK group started after the 116 132 Civil War. The KKK believe that White people are better. They want only White people to have power. They also want to keep people of color separate from White people. They are 148 especially against romantic relationships between White people and people of color. 159 The Ku Klux Klan grew larger during the civil rights movement. Many White people were 174 angry. They did not want Black people to have the same rights. The KKK used beatings, 190 bombings, and shootings to try to scare people. They wanted to stop people from voting or 206 speaking out. Since the 1960s, the Ku Klux Klan's numbers have gone down. There are only 222 228 a few thousand KKK members left.
