Part 2: Last read WPM At the 2008 Summer Olympics, the U.S. softball and baseball teams played well. The U.S. softball team won the silver medal, while the U.S. baseball team won bronze. Neither team, however, was given a chance to go for gold in 2012. In 2012, 43 baseball and softball were no longer Olympic sports. 51 63 How did this happen? Most weighty Olympic decisions are made by the International Olympic Committee, or IOC. The IOC has 115 members from all 75 over the world.
