HOW MANY IMMIGRANTS ARE THERE?

What do we mean when we talk about immigrants? We know that they are people from other countries. If you live in a city, there may be neighborhoods where the people come from a different culture and country, such as Mexico or India. Although these people may be immigrants, we should be careful not to confuse **ethnic minorities** with immigrants.
