

Chancelor Bennet grew up in the South Side of Chicago. He lived in a middle-class neighborhood called Chatham. He attended Chicago public schools as a child. Chancelor Bennet is also known as Chance the Rapper. He is a musician with three Grammy Awards.

In 2017, Chance donated \$1 million towards public schools in the South Side. Chance described58his donation as a "call to action." With his own daughter starting school, Chance worried about74other children. He wanted to make sure they could access quality education.86

The South Side is an area of Chicago that includes multiple neighborhoods. Chicago was100very segregated for many decades. African Americans could only live in about half of the115neighborhoods. Even after civil rights, many people were not able to move. That is why, even131today, most residents of the South Side are Black.140

Parts of the South Side suffer from poverty and gang violence. For many decades, though,155Chicago's South Side was an area of opportunity. There were manufacturing plants that offered169thousands of good jobs. Many Black people migrated to Chicago to take jobs like these. When185these plants shut down in the 60s and 70s, it hurt the area. Middle class people left the South204Side to find better jobs. Many businesses shut down. Schools, parks, and neighborhoods217declined.218

However, many people want to improve the South Side. Leaders have called for investment in 233 the area. They want South Side residents to have the same opportunities as others in Chicago. 249
