Chancellor Bennet grew up in the South Side of Chicago. He lived in a middle-class neighborhood called Chatham. He attended Chicago public schools as a child. Chancellor Bennet is also known as Chance the Rapper. He is a musician with three Grammy Awards.

In 2017, Chance donated \$1 million towards public schools in the South Side. Chance described his donation as a “call to action.” With his own daughter starting school, Chance worried about other children. He wanted to make sure they could access quality education. 58
