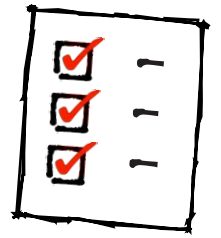

Every high school has its sports stars. If you ask these stars about their goals, many will mention college scholarships. But what does it mean to get a scholarship? Will these athletes be disappointed? 34

In fact, many people are unclear about what a scholarship means. For most athletes, it does not mean that college is free. The NCAA (National College Athletic Association) limits the amount of money that can be given in each sport. A Division 1 men’s soccer team can give no more than the equivalent of 9.9 full scholarships. And many schools give less. 49

Many Division 1 teams give no full scholarships. Instead, they give smaller scholarships to more players. They may give \$7,000 or \$10,000 a year. Division 1 colleges can cost \$70,000 a year. In addition, no NCAA scholarships are guaranteed. If a player has a bad season, her scholarship can be given to someone else. 109
