
Cause and effect


When we see two statements like these, we make a connection.




We talk about a **cause** (Kimmy missing the bus) and an **effect** (being late to school).

- → Causes are actions or situations that make other things happen.
- → Effects are the happenings that take place because of the cause.

Sometimes one cause can have more than one effect:



Other times several different causes can have one effect:



Linking words



We use **linking words** to connect causes and effects.

For example, we can say:

Notice that a **comma ,** also connects the cause and the effect when you start with a linking word.
